- The Schoolblazer website orientates around the pupils' gender and year group, ensuring you purchase the correct items.
- The site includes an "Intelligent Sizing" technology. Parents input their children's sizes into the site, which then recommends not only the correct fit garment for now but also describes how the garment will fit in a year's time.
- All orders placed online will receive free **sewn on nametapes**.
- Orders are shipped typically within two working days with a guarantee of five working days.
- Returns are free via the Royal Mail.
- Parents can still try on in Schoolblazer at Morningside Road and then place their order online to take advantage of free sewn on name taping.
